As we grow and expand the agriculture programs in Alumniville, our need for highly qualified teachers has increased. Currently, we are recruiting for Ag teaching positions in Alumniville for the upcoming school year. The ideal candidate will demonstrate knowledge of teaching the three-circle model of agricultural education and be comfortable teaching in an urban school system with diverse students, respect diversity in a variety of contexts, and work cooperatively with an interdisciplinary team of teachers in a career academy setting. Participation in FFA career development events and attendance at state and national FFA convention is expected. Experience or training in school-based greenhouse/horticulture production and management, project-based learning, and using the Curriculum for Agricultural Science Education (CASE) content is a plus. Positions are 10 month teaching assignments with an additional 40 days of extended employment to support student SAEs, summer activities, FFA Camp, etc. Additionally, the selected candidate must be able to spend 4 weeks at two separate CASE Institutes during the month of June 2015. Additional CASE training will occur annually.
