WASHINGTON LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

The Tennessee FFA Association is taking a bus trip to Washington, D.C. to be a part of the National FFA Organization's 2024 Washington Leadership Conference (WLC). WLC is a week of outstanding leadership training and touring our historic nation's capital. WLC is a life-changing experience, and I hope that you will encourage student leaders in your chapter to attend.

The Tennessee FFA's WLC bus trip is scheduled for July 15-21. The student fee for WLC in 2024 is \$1,400, and the advisor fee is \$1,500. This fee includes most meals, all lodging, conference materials, and bus transportation. A registration google form can be found on the state website and Camp Clements website. All WLC registration on the electronic form is due by February 1st. A \$50 deposit is due by February 1st to confirm a spot on the bus. The remaining balance for WLC will be due to the state FFA office in the spring once we hear back from National FFA.

In 2024 Tennessee FFA's WLC bus trip has only 48 spots available. I encourage those interested to submit their registration material early to secure a spot on the bus. The 2023 bus trip will have 4 advisor spots available. The advisor portion of the WLC trip is a great way to not only see our nation's capital, but also to engage with other agricultural education teachers from across the nation.
