**Greetings Tennessee FFA Advisors.
Please read the following information concerning
instructions for application as some have changed.**

***YouTube links must be emailed to Windy Pinnix at
pinnixw@rcschools.net by February 26, 2026.**

- Please attach a YouTube link of your student performing the talent they are submitting, in the email with the application. If your student is singing, playing an instrument etc, I need 30 to 45 seconds of three different preferred selections. We will not have more than one student performing the same selection.
- Name of Student
- Name of FFA Chapter
- Name, email, and phone number of Advisor
- Name of the Three Selections performing, if applicable.

*Advisors it is requested that you review the performance before submitting.

* *Things to consider:*

1. Students MUST PERFORM IN OFFICIAL FFA DRESS unless the act requires another costume. Exceptions must be approved by staff or Talent Coordinator.
2. Please do not submit acts that require stage props, scenery, etc.
3. Remember, the auditorium is large. Acts such as magicians, ventriloquists and pantomimes are not really suited for the big stage.

** Students participating in State FFA Talent are responsible for:*

- All expenses incurred in travel, lodging and meals
- Convention registration fees

*There will be a mandatory talent meeting after the Monday morning session in front of the stage in the auditorium. Please have student and/or advisor attend.

*Students selected to perform who will be bringing pre-recorded music will need to bring it in **MP3, Wav, or mp4 format. CD's and jump drives are also acceptable.** Absolutely no direct playing from YouTube. Please add the student's name to all music.
