

### **Goals & Objectives**

- 1. To allow alumni, supporters, and businesses to have a positive impact on the success of the FFA by providing financial support to the FFA through monetary and in-kind contributions.
- 2. To create an endowment fund that will perpetuate funds necessary for the operation of the Tennessee FFA Association.
- 3. To obtain funds for the general fund that will allow the Tennessee FFA Foundation, Inc. to operate in a positive financial environment.
- 4. To obtain sponsors for individual FFA events and award programs that will fully fund these programs in each region and at the state level.
- 5. To receive memorials that will allow individuals to contribute in the memory

- of loved ones and to allow individuals to designate a portion of their estate to the Tennessee FFA Foundation.
- 6. To ensure that Camp Clements remains an important part of the FFA program in Tennessee and to ensure that a permanent location for the history of Tennessee FFA be built and maintained at Camp Clements.
- 7. To ensure the three-circle model of agricultural education (FFA, Supervised Agricultural Experience, and Classroom/Laboratory) is fully implemented in Tennessee by funding state and national membership dues for every student enrolled in agricultural education.



the devastating impacts of COVID-19, there was a bright spot that deserves a permanent place on the Tennessee FFA timeline.

In the summer of 2020, the Tennessee FFA Foundation Board of Directors boldly dedicated the funds necessary to pay membership dues for every student enrolled in agricultural education in this state. Previously, membership was reserved only for those students who had the means and motivation to pay local, regional, state, and national dues.

Although \$12-\$30 (depending on the chapter) does not seem like a meaningful sum to most of the people reading this article, to a freshman high school student who has barely started their first agriculture class and has to go home to mom, dad, or a caregiver with their handout (yet again), membership dues can be the deterring barrier to involvement in FFA. And, that was the case for thousands of Tennessee students.

In the wake of the Foundation's action,
Tennessee FFA membership grew from 14,527
members to 26,977 members. Tennessee went
from thirteenth in the nation to fifth in a single
academic year. That growth meant Tennessee
FFA membership reached an all-time high. And,
2022 membership is poised to eclipse that of the
past two years.

Here is why FFA membership growth matters: Agricultural education is based on a threecomponent model that makes it unlike any other course or program area offered in schools. Students must be enrolled in an agricultural education course, maintain a Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) project, and be a member of FFA. This model makes for a well-rounded experience that delivers experiential learning and career preparation that readies students for life after school – whatever that entails.

FFA has seen its members go on to be successful farmers, agribusiness leaders, entrepreneurs, industrial and manufacturing workers, bankers, attorneys, teachers, and much more.

FFA LEADERSHIP

You name the career field, and there is almost certainly a former FFA member in the mix.

Rooted in agriculture, with an eye toward developing top-notch leaders, FFA is one-of-a-kind. It is often mistaken for an after-school program. To the contrary, FFA is "intracurricular," meaning members must be enrolled in an agricultural education class, and that grade will contribute to their grade point

average just like math, science, and reading.
Enrollment in agricultural education courses
produces young adults who are informed
consumers, who are conversant in issues
affecting food prices, who can grasp the concept
of supply and demand, and who know that food
came off a farm before it came off a shelf.

Management of a years-long Supervised Agricultural Experience project produces young adults who have learned responsibility and organizational skills, who know the importance of time management, who have experienced the joy of achieving something that required a sustained effort over time, and who know that not everything in this world comes to us through immediate gratification or the click of a mouse.

Involvement in FFA produces young adults who know what it is like to introduce themselves in front of a group, who can give an effective handshake, who can tie a tie or walk in dress

shoes, and who can participate in school board meetings because they have learned parliamentary procedure.

Now, imagine a world full of young people just like those described above. That is why we need more FFA members, and that is why membership matters.

# THE SPIRIT OF SERVICE

## Tennessee Farmers Cooperative Drives Support to New Levels

or nearly a century, the spirit of service has been at the heart of both Tennessee FFA and Tennessee Farmers Cooperative. While FFA members live to serve through premier leadership, personal growth, and career success, Tennessee Farmers Cooperative is "Driven to Serve" through agricultural products and services for the producers of our food, fuel, and fiber supply. Oftentimes, Tennessee FFA members are the very customers and producers that Co-op is "Driven to Serve." Beyond the storefront, Tennessee Farmers Cooperative is also serving Tennessee FFA through its incredible fundraising efforts - all for the sake of preparing agricultural youth to lead the industry into the future.

Tennessee Farmers Cooperative is a grassroots agricultural supplier that includes 49 member Co-ops, 27 associate members, 164 retail outlets, and 70,000 farmers who are member-owners of their local Co-ops. This model has strengthened Tennessee Farmers Cooperative into one of the

leading federated farm supply systems in the nation.

Although Tennessee Farmers Cooperative has been a faithful supporter of Tennessee FFA for many years, their support reached new heights with the inception of the Co-op Auction Barn in 2017. The Co-op Auction Barn is a spirited auction held in conjunction with the TFC Annual Meeting each November that directly supports Tennessee FFA and Tennessee 4-H. From the distinctive auction items to the remarkably generous bids, it is a collaboration of the entire Co-op community. Due to the hardships of the COVID-19 pandemic, an online bidding option was added to the Co-op Auction Barn and has drastically increased the success of the event. Bidders beyond those attending the TFC Annual Meeting are able to participate and bolster the auction's impact. Since 2018, the auction has grown 500%, totaling \$86,000 in support of FFA and 4-H just in 2021.

"Tennessee Farmers Cooperative has touched the lives of innumerable FFA members over the last six years through this auction. Many of our programs would not be possible without the dedicated support of TFC, its board members, and its employees, as well as the selfless spirit behind every bid," said Chelsea Rose, Executive Director of the Tennessee FFA Foundation.

In addition to the Co-op Auction Barn, Tennessee Farmers Cooperative creates a yearly, commemorative 4-H/FFA pocket knife in collaboration with W.R. Case and Sons. The unique tradition is now in its 22nd year and has raised nearly half a million dollars for the two youth organizations. The knives, which feature the logos of Co-op, 4-H, and FFA, have grown to be highly coveted collectors' items. They are available at local Co-op stores at the end of every year.

Through the Co-op Auction Barn proceeds and commemorative knife sales, Tennessee Farmers Cooperative truly makes a positive difference in the lives of Tennessee FFA members. Two proficiency awards, the Prepared Public Speaking contest, the Star in Agribusiness Award, regional banquets, and the FFA Ham

Breakfast are just a few of the areas that Tennessee Farmers Cooperative impacts.

In 2022, Tennessee Farmers Cooperative was the Presenting Sponsor of the 94th Tennessee FFA State Convention, allowing thousands of members to finally gather for the first time since 2019 for a full-force convention with an exciting and lively atmosphere. The State Officer Selection Process, held during the convention, is also made possible through these funds and ensures Tennessee FFA is led by the best and brightest young minds amongst the membership.

The Tennessee FFA Goodwill Tour is a longstanding tradition that is also impacted by the generosity of Tennessee Farmers Cooperative. During the Goodwill Tour, the Tennessee FFA State Officers spend National FFA Week visiting businesses, FFA chapters, and agriculture industry leaders to promote the mission and vision of FFA.





Tennessee State Fair FFA Ham Breakfast Celebrates Year 7 with Record-Breaking Haul

Thirling rides, funnel cakes, and bright lights lure thousands to the Tennessee State Fair each year, but at the very foundation of the fair is the industry that feeds us all — agriculture. Not only is the Tennessee State Fair a hub of entertainment,



but it is also a true celebration and showcase of Tennessee's rich agricultural resources.

In 2015, a new element of this agricultural showcase was brought forth with the inception of the breakfast. The breakfast has grown into Tennessee FFA's largest fundraiser and the premier agricultural networking event of the year.

Leaders from agriculture, government, and business contribute to FFA as sponsors of the breakfast and make the career and leadership development programming of Tennessee FFA possible. Attendees enjoy a country breakfast, a lineup of influential speakers, the auctioning of the state fair-winning country and packer-style hams, and most importantly, connecting with FFA members.

For seven years, the Tennessee State Fair has hosted the Tennessee FFA Ham Breakfast. The event was originally held in Nashville, with the help and support of the Tennessee State Fair Association. It found a new home in Lebanon in 2021 when the fair moved to Wilson County. The Farm Bureau Exposition Center, the Wilson County Fairgrounds' spacious event hall, gave the Ham Breakfast plenty of room to grow.

The move marked a new era for the Tennessee FFA Ham Breakfast as capacity doubled, allowing more business, community, and state leaders to support Tennessee FFA through their sponsorship. A key player in making the breakfast successful from the start is former Tennessee State Fair Association Chairman and Past Tennessee FFA State Officer, Congressman John Rose.

"The experiences this organization affords young people are not just beneficial, they're transformative," said Rose. "It's essential that leaders from all sectors see what FFA is doing for students and that we immerse them in the world of agriculture, even for a few hours."

In 2015, the inaugural Ham Breakfast raised approximately \$20,000, with more than 400 community leaders, FFA members, and sponsors in attendance. In addition, the ham auction garnered a total of \$8,400. Each year, despite a one-year reprieve due to COVID-19, the Ham Breakfast has broken the previous sponsorship, attendee, and fundraising records.

Seven years after the first breakfast, the 2022 event raised more money than ever before with over \$173,000 raised (\$24,000 coming from the ham auction) and more than 1,100 guests in attendance from across the state. The growth of the breakfast is a true testament to Tennessee's

growing belief in the young leaders that come

from FFA.

From grassroots organizations to local businesses to Fortune 500 companies, supporters of the breakfast run the gamut. Many FFA alumni also give back to the organization to ensure current and future FFA members receive the same opportunities they once did. One such FFA alum is Jimmy Comer from Lebanon, who now serves as a leader in both the fair and the Ham Breakfast.

"The Ham Breakfast was a crown jewel of the fair that we were proud to adopt," said Comer.
