# Parking and Navigating Instructions

The offices and committee rooms of the Tennessee General Assembly are located in the Cordell Hull State Office Building (CHB), located at 425 Rep. John Lewis Way North.

CHB is situated just east of the State Capitol near the corner of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. and Rep. John Lewis Way North.

# DIRECTIONS TO CHB FROM PARKING GARAGES

#### FROM WeGo:


 Exit at West elevator/stairs and turn right. Cross over Rep. John Lewis Way N and CHB will be on your left.

# FROM PREMIER PARKING or 400 CHARLOTTE:

 Exit at Dr. MLK Jr. Blvd and walk West, turn right on Rep. John Lewis Way N, CHB will be on your left



Restrooms are located on all floors of CHB at the north and south (left to right) ends of the building. Vending machines – both beverage and snacks – also can be found on each floor.

### ENTERING CHB

All visitors to CHB must go through a security checkpoint before gaining access to the building. Similar to airport security, all bags and coats must pass through an x-ray machine and individuals must pass through metal detectors. In addition, all visitors must present photo identification at the security checkpoint.

## FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND

CHB is a 10-floor building, including the ground floor, on which you will enter. A central bank of elevators located just past security will take you to all floors. In addition, a central staircase connects the ground, first and second floors.
